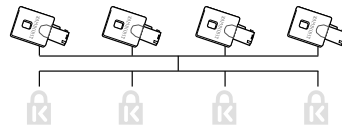
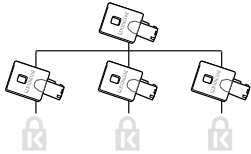

Master-Keyed. Each Slim MicroSaver® in an order has a unique set of keys, but one master key created during manufacturing can open all the locks in that order. The Master-Key option offers IS/IT/Facilities management more control over equipment security and prevents downtime caused by misplaced keys.

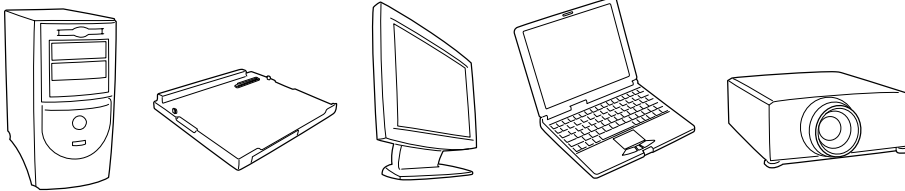
Like-Keyed. Each Slim MicroSaver in an order has the same lock and may be opened with any of the identical keys. Especially well-suited for companies with lower risk of internal theft, the Like-Keyed option permits employees to access any secured equipment and doesn't require a manager to hold a master key.

Nearly all notebook computers, flat screen monitors, and projectors manufactured today include the built-in Kensington security slot. Many new desktop computers also incorporate the Kensington security slot to lock the chassis shut.
